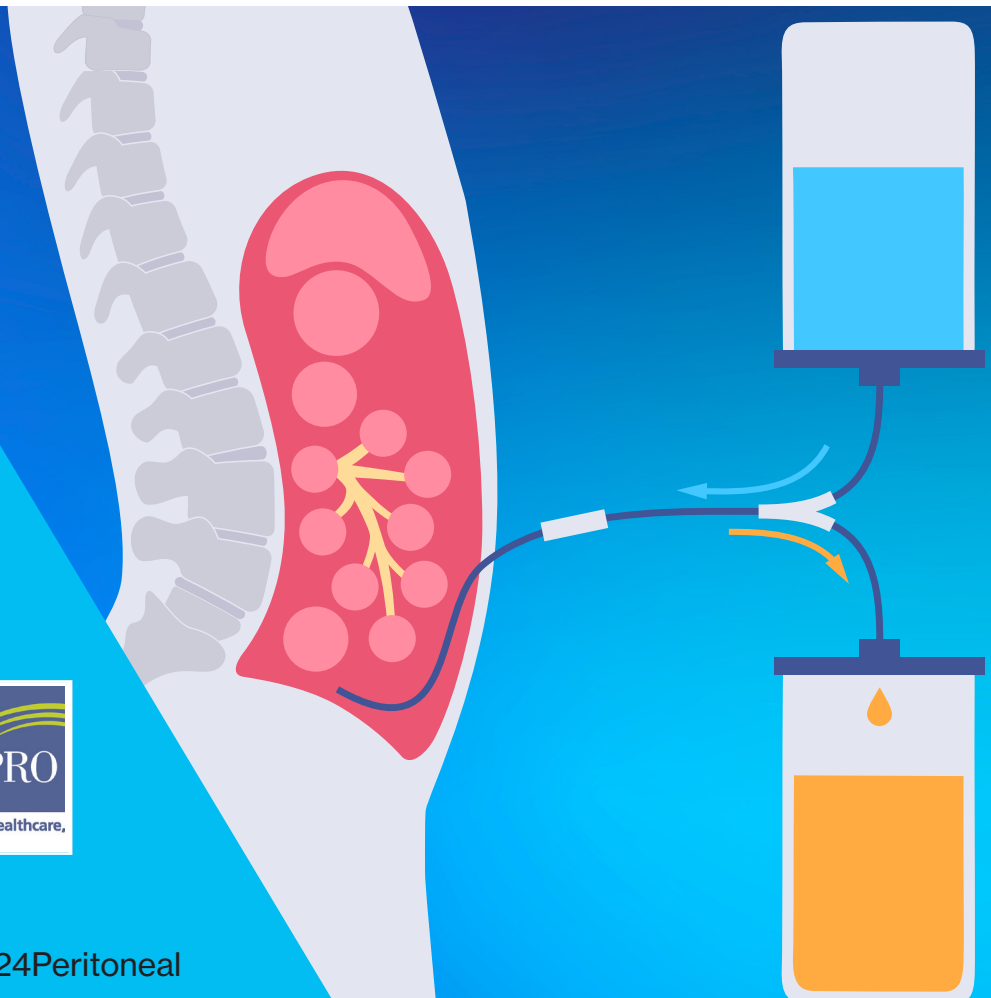

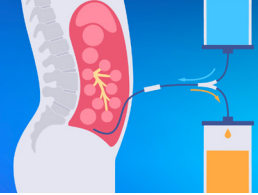

This is a one day in person conference on home dialysis sponsored by the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai. Practitioners, researchers, clinician-scientists and RNs who are experts in the field of kidney disease will discuss current developments in the field of Peritoneal Dialysis and related dialysis modalities. There will be a variety of topics, including roundtable discussion with patients on increasing the utilization and retention of home dialysis.

Conference Objectives

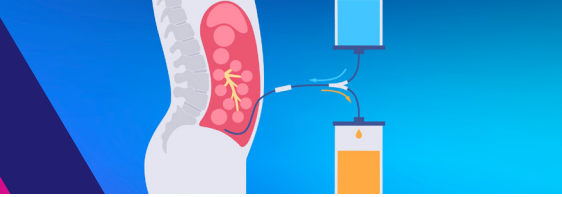

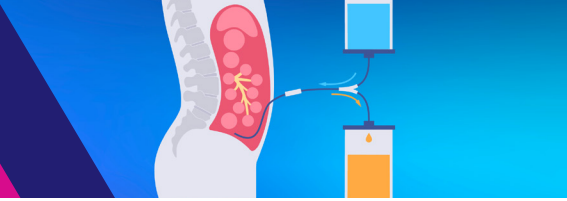

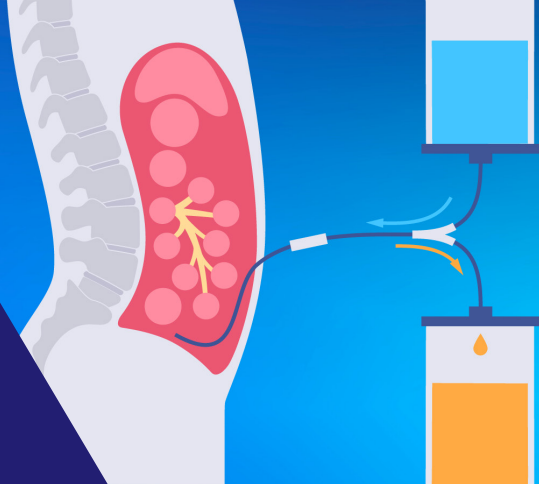
