

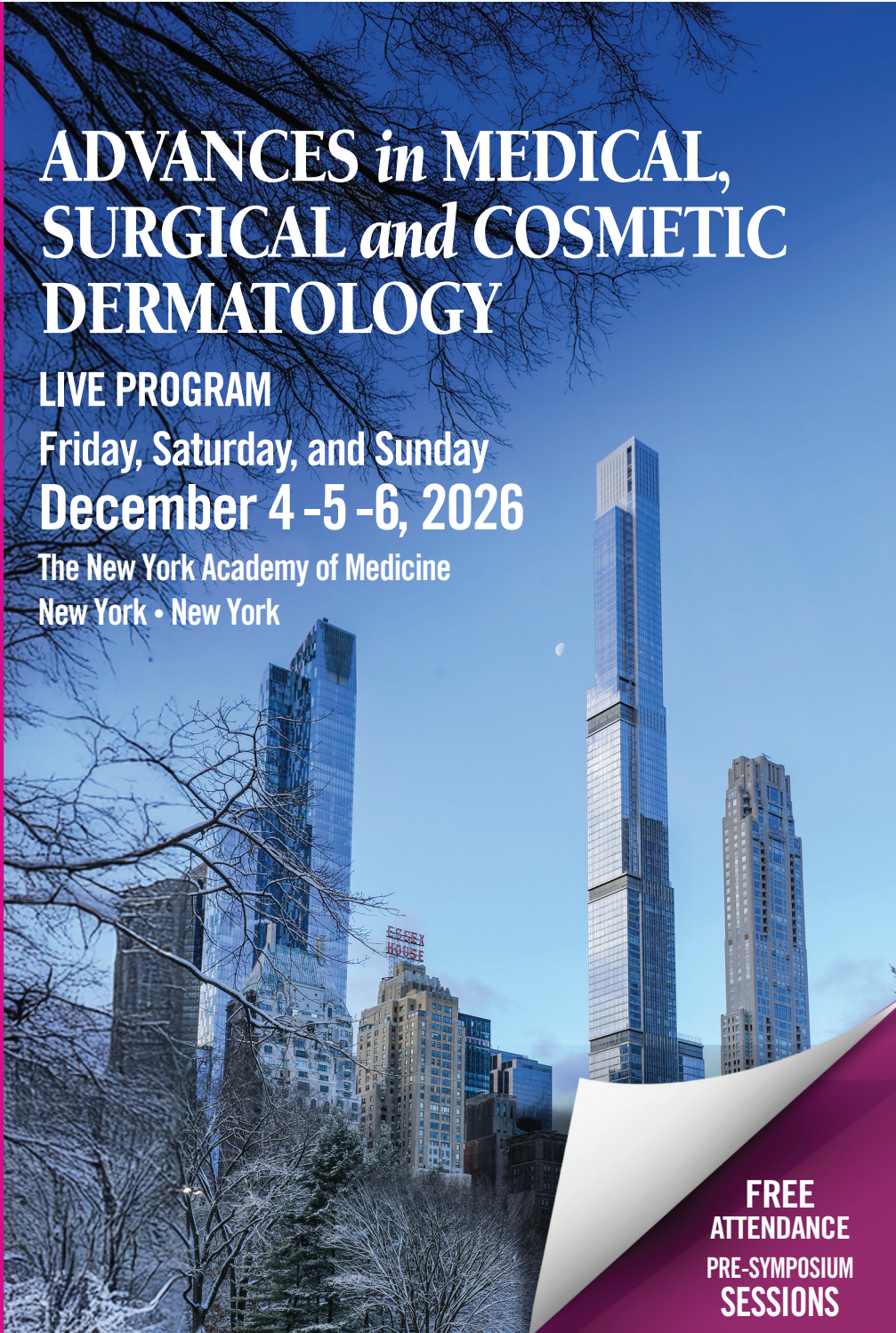

GOALS & OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of the symposium, participants will be able to:

- Evaluate emerging evidence and landmark studies in medical, surgical, cosmetic dermatology, and dermatopathology and incorporate relevant findings into clinical practice
