OBJECTIVES

- Apply knowledge regarding recent advances in the effective and safe treatment and management of cosmetic challenges and facial oncologic pathology.

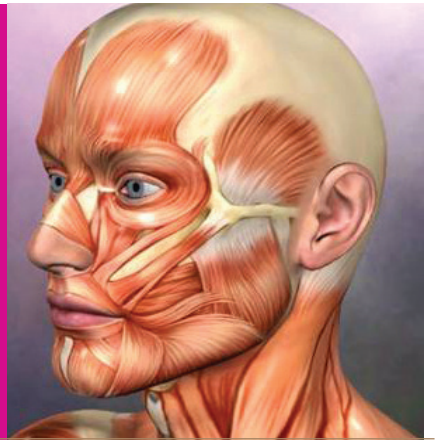
