GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Update on the changes in diagnostic practices, definitions of eligibility for GH treatment and dosing practices for newer GH preparations and other growth promoting agents.
- Recognize health disparities in the treatment of diabetes mellitus to effect change in practice.
