General Information

Course Description

The purpose of this seminar is to provide updates on disorders related to pregnancy and the pelvic floor. We will learn about obstacles associated with developments in urogynecologic, gynecologic, and colorectal surgery. The seminar will update providers on pelvic floor disorders, discuss new technical knowledge for treating fecal incontinence and colorectal conditions during and post pregnancy, and discussions on the pros and cons of Elective Primary Cesarean Section and Operative Vaginal Delivery, in the context of understanding the overall decision-making process for management of pelvic floor disorders. In addition, the seminar aims to help physicians and healthcare professionals coordinate care for patients with pelvic floor disorders that require multi-disciplinary care.

Course Objectives

1. Review all new technologies for treatment of colorectal and pelvic floor disorders in pregnant patients.
2. Discuss disorders of pregnancy and the pelvic floor.
3. Discuss colorectal disorders experienced pre and postpartum.
4. Discuss new technologies utilized in treating and diagnosing disorders of the pelvic floor during pregnancy.

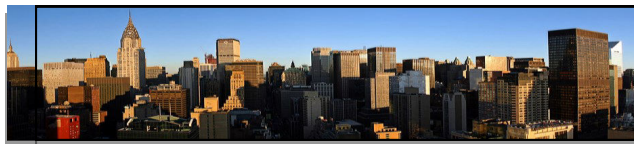
