## Internet Live Course: Frequently Asked Questions

### General

- **What does “live online” mean?**

An internet live course is an online course available at a certain time on a certain date and is only available in real-time, just as if it were a course held in an auditorium. Once the event has taken place, learners may no longer participate in that activity. Examples include a livestream, webcast, or webinar.

- **Are all live online programs the same in terms of format and length?**

- **Do I have to attend all live sessions?**

Participants are expected to attend all sessions. However, we understand that participants may have scheduling conflicts. We will also record most faculty sessions, which you can review upon request. However, you may only claim the number of credits for which you were in actual attendance.

- **Will I need to attend the live sessions even if I’m in a different time zone?**

You are required to attend all internet live sessions, even if you are based in a different time zone. Find the time difference between several cities with the Time Difference [Calculator](#). This activity is held in the Eastern Time Zone. [New York]

### Certification

- **How many credits does this internet live course offer?**
